



GUEST POLICIES & DRESS CODE

GOLF GUESTS

All Guests must be registered in the Pro Shop Guest Book prior to playing. Play is limited to twice per month, tournaments excepted. Guests must be accompanied by at least one Member per four- some unless as approved Unaccompanied Guests. Members are responsible for Guest conduct, dress, and all charges. Special Guest provisions for Guest play prior to Memorial Day and after Labor Day may be made through the Golf Professional Staff.

GOLF DRESS CODE

Denim is not allowed to be worn on the Golf Course or Practice Facilities. Gentlemen must wear golf shirts, tucked in, with collars and sleeves. Slacks or golf shorts must always be worn on the golf course. Tank tops, t-shirts, cutoffs, cargo shorts, sweatpants, bathing suits, athletic shorts, gym apparel, tennis shorts or shorts with frayed edges are not permitted on the golf course or practice areas at any time. Golf hats and visors must be worn with the bill facing forwards, not backwards. Golf shoes or footwear designed for the golf course must be worn at all times. Ladies must wear proper golf attire which includes golf shorts, shirts, golf slacks or golf attire similar to what is sold in the golf shop. Golf shorts or skorts must be no shorter than the mid-thigh. No halter tops, t-shirts, bathing suits, sweatpants, yoga attire, gym apparel, tennis shorts, athletic shorts, or short shorts. Ladies may wear sleeveless tops with a collar. If the top has no collar, it must have sleeves. Racerback tank tops allowed only with a collar. Leggings allowed only under a skort or shorts. Parents are asked to oversee their children's dress and guide them appropriately. Members are responsible for their guests' appearance while on Club property.

CLUBHOUSE GUESTS

All members must accompany their guests to the club. The same guests are allowed two visits per month to the pool, racquets & golf. Guests are always welcome with members to the dining room. Guests must always be accompanied by the Member with the exception of House Guests. Members are responsible for all charges incurred by their guests. Guests must be registered for golf, tennis, or pool activities with the name of the hosting Member.

CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE

Good taste and judgment should always prevail in the absence of a specific requirement. Warwick Country Club prefers that its members and guests dress up rather than dress down when visiting the Club.

Clubhouse/Country Club attire; business attire, business casual or golf course attire. Appropriate attire for men includes business slacks, khakis, modern style five-pocket pants (no cargo/side pockets) and collared shirts. Golf appropriate shorts (no cargo/side pockets) may also be worn. Tailored button-down dress shirts are not required to be tucked in, unless on the golf course or practice facilities. Golf shirts must always remain tucked in on and off the golf course. Casual dress appropriate shoes or loafers are required. Examples of acceptable attire for women includes business slacks, dress capris, skirts and dress shorts, tailored shirts, blouses and sweaters. Denim jeans are not to be worn at the Club or on the property. T-shirts, bathing suits and sweatshirts/hoodies are limited to the pool/lawn/beach areas and are **not** to be worn in the clubhouse, dining rooms, deck or pro-shop. Attire for minors should reflect the same policy as the adults. All Guests must adhere to the dress code of the club.
